Most doctors will issue a second inhaler so that it can be left in school rather than taken home and returned each day. Thank you.

If your child has been vomiting or has had diarrhoea, please ensure you keep them off school for 48 hours after the last bout, to prevent the germs spreading. This is particularly important for the younger children. Thank you for your co-operation.
